

Fractal 1st Burn, Tan Salmon Stain 2



Description (150 max)

Fractal burn pattern on a tan wood with the Salmon scheme then washed to stain.

Additional Detail

Fractal burning, also called Lichtenberg etching, is a Process that creates images on wood using high-voltage electricity and a conductive solution.

The textures are from three different woods (Tan poplar, Dark Brazil and Red Wood). These "Exotic woods" are sanded smooth and imaged for the textures. I use a Neon Sign Transformer (10KV 30mA) and a solution of water, salt and baking soda. The resulting burns are cleaned and imaged and digitally processed.

Texture is a PNG file at 4096 X 4096 pixels.
